

Committee of Management Report

The Committee of Management met last week. During the meeting, we went through the regular reports from the Sub Committees, the Centre Manager's Report, an Update on the New Kinder Building, and discussed Risk Management.

Finance - presented a draft of the Annual Accounts as of December 31st in preparation for the Audit which is now taking place. A summary of the Bank Balances and statements were presented to the meeting. Finance passed a quote for further maintenance on the West End of the playground. Grounds and Maintenance - The committee discussed the maintenance work that had been done in the playground and visited the site. We also discussed the proposed repair to the fence by the Wellington Shire and further maintenance.

Policies - The following policies were reviewed and passed - Dealing with Infectious Diseases, Sustainability, Governance and Management Policy, Emergency and Evacuation, and Nutrition, Oral Health and Active Play.

Centre Manager's Report: The Centre Manager gave a report on the month's events, including continuing strong numbers, the installation of new cots and high chairs in the Babies Room, and a new fridge in the same area. The report covered the Gastro Outbreak and the management of the centre during this time, and the planned Vacation Care Program for OSHC and Kinder children.

Sarah also gave us an update of the renovations for relocating the Maternal Health Centre and the setting up of a Manager's Office in the Centre.

Reference Group for the New Kinder Building - our Representatives on this group were excited to present drawings of the new building and a site plan.

Curriculum and Programming Support - Previous 4 Year Old Kinder Teacher and Educational Leader, Jo Nunn, has returned to the Kinder in an advisory and support role to develop Curriculum, Programming and implementation with the Educators.

Alberton OSHC - The Alberton OSHC will commence on April 24th with the possibility of Vacation Care happening as well. Bookings are through YELC on 0351825190 and Ros Hudson will be managing the site.


